Name: •UIL 2007 Region VII Class 5-A Swimming and Diving Championships

Dates: •February 2 and 3, 2007

Venue: •Davis Natatorium
•Blossom Athletic Center (North East Stadium)
•Jones-Maltsberger Road at Starcrest / Bitters
•San Antonio, TX 78217
•210-491-6132

Facility: •Eight FINA-width (2.75-meters) lanes
•0.75-meter buffers outside lanes one and eight
•2.25-meter minimum depth
•All automatic starting and timing
•Full real-time scoreboard with heat and event display
•Scoreboard operates in the adjacent Walker warm-up / cool down pool (16 lanes)
•Off-deck seating for 1500
•Spectators **are not** permitted on deck.
•Concessions and swim shop in the lobby

Rules: •The 2006 - 2007 National Federation Swimming, Diving, and Water Polo Rules will govern this meet
•The USA Swimming Whistle Start Procedure will be in use at this meet

Natatorium

Rules: •All swimmers and divers are required to wear their approved uniforms and warm-ups
•Hats, body or face painting, costumes, and /or props will not be allowed
•Organized cheers by schools teams will be allowed on deck in front of the designated seating area specified for each school
•All spirit groups and team mascots must stay in the spectator area and will not be allowed on deck
•Athletes and / or teams that violate these rules will be subject to disciplinary action that could include disqualification from the competition

National Time

Verification: •This meet has been approved by USA Swimming for NTV purposes
•In order for a time from a high school championship or season ending meet to be entered into the USA Swimming (USA-S) National SWIMS Database, the athlete must be **currently** registered with USA-S – **AND** – the athlete's USA Swimming ID Number must be accurately entered into the Meet Manager Database
•No further action by either the coach or the athlete is necessary
•ALL swims involving the backstroke will be observed by USA Swimming Certified Officials and exceptions to the technical rules will be noted to the NTV Officer on deck

Meet

Format: •Championship with a single heat in final
•In preliminaries: ten minute break after the men's 200-yard medley relay, 500-yard freestyle, and 100-yard breaststroke
•In preliminaries: fifteen minute break after 50-yard freestyle
•Nominal 45 seconds between races
•In finals: ten minute break after the men's 200-yard medley relay and 500-yard freestyle
•Women's final diving break after the 50-yard freestyle
•Men's final diving break after the men's 100-yard breaststroke

- Nominal 90 seconds between the other events
- In the finals session a “ready room,” located in the weight room, will be in operation
- Qualifiers must report to the “ready room” **no later** than one event prior to their scheduled swim

Entry

- Restrictions:**
- Each swimmer may enter four events, no more than two of which may be individual events
 - No school may enter more than four swimmers in any single individual event
 - Each school is limited to one relay team per relay event

- Relays:**
- Only the four (4) swimmers declared on the front of the relay card are permitted to report to the blocks and compete
 - If the swimmers are to be correctly noted in the Final Results, the order of swimming must also be specified
 - Relay cards for the preliminary* 200-yard Medley Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than thirty (30) minutes prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. Penalty #1. under Rule 3.2.1 will apply
 - Relay cards for the preliminary* 200-yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the start of the men’s 500-yard freestyle. . Penalty #1. under Rule 3.2.1 will apply
 - Relay cards for the preliminary* 400-yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the start of the women’s 100-yard breaststroke. Penalty #1. under Rule 3.2.1 will apply
 - Once relay cards have been turned in to the Official Scorer, no changes will be permitted and post-meet corrections cannot be made
 - For the finals* session, if there is no change in the order of swimmers or the makeup of a relay team, the Official Score will **NOT** require a new card be submitted
 - For the finals* session, if there is a change in **either** the order of the swimmers or the makeup of a relay team a **NEW** card must be prepared and submitted to the Official Scorer as noted above
- *In the cases where there are eight (8) or fewer entries for any relay event, it will be contested as a timed final in the finals session only and **NOT** swum in preliminaries – the card submission restrictions noted above will, however, apply

- Procedures**
- Entries are preferably to be submitted by Hy-Tek Commlink File or disk
 - Hard copy must accompany
 - Please format disks before utilizing for entries
 - Commlink Files may be submitted by e-mail (please see section just below)
 - Alternatively, entries may be submitted on handwritten forms available on the AAAA Web Site (www.aaaa-sa.org)
 - Each entry must include the swimmer’s full name, swimmers school affiliation / grade, and a seedtime
 - Entries received without a seedtime will be rejected

- Entries:**
- Entries in Commlink Format only, **MUST** be sent only to: djohns1@neisd.net
 - The Commlink File must be renamed to clearly identify the entering team, the shorter the better
 - Athletes included in improperly identified Commlink Files (Cfile0X.cl2 or zfile00X.zip) will not be entered into the meet and any entry fees will not be refunded
 - Athletes WILL NOT be entered into Meet Manager until the Meet Entry Report (hard copy) is received as an attachment to the e-mail, via FAX (210-491-6133), or hand-delivered
 - Athletes WILL NOT be permitted to compete in the meet until satisfactory fee payment arrangements have been made with the Meet Director or designee
 - Considerably more detailed instructions in a PDF Document will be found on the Forms, etc. Page (left-hand column near the bottom) of the AAAA Web Site (www.aaaa-sa.org/Forms.htm)

- FAX Entries:**
- Under no circumstances will entries be accepted via FAX
 - Entry Reports WILL be accepted via FAX
- Entry Fees:**
- \$12.00 per athlete
 - Checks payable to **NEISD**.
- Scratch Rules:**
- Championship format
 - Scratches are not permitted
 - Swimmers who fail to appear for any competition which they have entered or have qualified for, will be disqualified from further competition
 - Previous performances will not be nullified
 - Failures to compete by reason of illness or injury are excepted, as are alternates
 - An individual swimmer or relay team may withdraw from competition without penalty in any given event by declaring a false start
 - The Meet Referee will designate the time and place for such declarations.
- Alternates:**
- Swimmers who qualify as alternates for final events and wish to compete should no shows occur, must be within an area previously designated by the Meet Referee and be immediately available
 - Immediately is defined as being properly attired, on the block, and ready to swim within 30 seconds of being called.
- Diving:**
- National Federation Rules will apply
 - 11-dive format
 - 1-meter board only
 - Five (5) voluntary dives and six (6) optional dives must be performed
 - All divers must be entered with their high school team via Hy-Tek Commlink
 - Completed dive sheets must be sent to the Diving Referee by the Entry Deadline
 - All corrections / revisions must be in the hands of the Diving Referee not later than one hour prior to the scheduled start of competition.

Special Note:**

- All deck officials must be currently (2006-2007) registered with TISCA / NFHS and have worked at least one of the District Championship meets during the current season
- The Meet Referee will make all deck assignments two or three days BEFORE the meet
- Therefore, all officials who desire to be assigned to deck positions MUST notify the Meet Referee of their intentions and availability NOT LATER than 6:00 PM, Sunday, January 28th
- Please specify the sessions for which you will be available and in which Class

- You WILL NOT be assigned if your commitment and information are not submitted or not received by the deadline
- Uniforms for deck officials will be as follows:
 - Preliminaries** – white shirts/blouses over navy blue pants, skirts, or Bermuda length shorts (NO JEANS PLEASE)
 - Finals** – navy blue shirts/blouses over white pants or skirts (NO SHORTS OR JEANS, PLEASE), navy blue blazers with white shirt and mostly red tie are optional
