SUBJECT: 2008-09 Swimming Honor Roll

In addition to maintaining national records in swimming, the National Federation compiles an Honor Roll to recognize outstanding individual performances from the previous year. The top 10 performances in each event are published annually in the National High School Sports Record Book.

It is time to begin compiling the Swimming Honor Roll for the 2010 record book, which will recognize the top performances in swimming during the 2009-10 season. We need your help to make these lists as comprehensive and accurate as possible.

Swimming Honor Roll forms for girls and boys are attached. Please list all of the best single performances of each individual and team from your high school for the 2009-10 season that equal or better the stated minimum times. *The UIL will submit the swimmers who qualify at the State Meet to the National Federation automatically.* The form should be returned as soon as the swimming season is completed to the UIL office by fax (512-471-6589) no later than March 15, 2010.

Please note that any national record candidates in swimming require completion of the High School Swimming Record Application as well as the honor roll form. You can obtain a national record application form for swimming by calling the UIL office at 512-471-5883. Outstanding performances attained either during preliminaries or finals may be recognized.

Only swimming record performances in yards should be sent to the UIL Office. Metric record applications should be directed to the National Interscholastic Swimming Coaches Association (NISCA). Swimming record applications should be sent by March 15, 2010.
