ENTRIES: In UIL championship meets, each school may enter a maximum of four competitors in an individual event, and one team in each of the relay events. A competitor/team is officially entered when the official entry sheet is delivered to the meet manager at the designated time and place. In relay events, 8 individuals may be listed as the entry, any four of whom shall be assigned to swim. This will count as an entry for each person listed only if they swim on the relay in prelims or finals. A swimmer may swim in a maximum of four events, no more than two of these events may be individual events.

All competitors, once officially entered shall compete all heats, swim-offs, and rounds of competition for which they qualify, except when an illness or injury forces a competitor to withdraw. This applies to individual members of relay teams, not entire teams, as well as competitors in individual events. Failure to compete for any reason other than illness or injury shall disqualify the competitor from any further competition in the meet. Previous performances are not nullified. A competitor may be reinstated by the referee in a later event after illness/injury if a certified physician or referee verifies recuperation.

DIVING: Each diver will submit a signed dive sheet which is due Tuesday, 2/09/10 by 4:00 pm. Changes may be made up until one hour prior to the start of the diving competition. Diving competition will be run electronically. Each diver shall perform eleven dives, five voluntary and six optional. Please refer to the National Federation rule book for the order of dives (Rule Book, p. 62, Sec. 4, Art. 1). **If you have a diver, please take the TISCA diving judges test and plan on judging.**

ENTRY FORMS: Coaches are strongly encouraged to send entries via e-mail using Hy-Tek TM, or TM Lite. **You MUST include student's numerical grade level on electronic entries and be sure to use the correct school code assigned by the UIL. Please leave LSC code blank.** You MUST declare your eight (8) swimmers for each relay. Electronic entries must be received by the meet director Tuesday, February 2, 2010.

UIL entry sheets (found in coach's manual) **MUST** be sent as back-up and received by the meet director at least ten days prior to the district meet. You **MUST** place the **student's numerical grade level on UIL form.** ****If using Team Manager, you may go to the "Reports" button on the task bar and select "Meet Reports" then select "Meet Entries Spreadsheet". Please include the information asked for at the top of the UIL form (City, School, 4A, District, Region, Coach, Phone Number) then fax it in.**

SCORING: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11 ~ Championship Finals individual events and double for relays.

9 - 7 - 6 - 5 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1 ~ Consolation Finals for individual events and double for relays.

AWARDS: Team trophies will be awarded to the Region Champion in both the girls and boys divisions.

Medals will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers in each event. Ribbons will be awarded to the 4th through 8th place finishers in each event. Certificates will be awarded to the Outstanding Male and Female Diver and Swimmers. This is a TISCA award and will be figured through Hy-Tek Meet Manager Program.

state QUALIFIERS: The winner of each swimming event and the top two finishers in diving will advance to the State Championship in Austin, February 26 & 27, 2010.

BULKHEAD TRAFFIC: All traffic for the swimmers on the bulkhead will be from Lane 1 towards Lane 8.

WARM-UP / COOL DOWN: The diving well may be used for warming up and cooling down during the meet. **However, the lane nearest the starting blocks will be closed.** Also, please inform your athletes to be aware that there is a foot ledge 5' beneath the surface on each of the turning walls as well as at the starting end of the competition pool.

LOCKER ROOMS: All girls will use the 2 locker rooms available in the pool area. The boy's locker room is located downstairs.

COACHES AND OFFICIALS MEETING: 1:45pm Friday and 10:45 Saturday

ADMISSION: Adults ~ \$ 5.00 Students ~ \$ 3.00

We ask that **all** spectators sit in the designated area for spectators which are in the permanent bleachers and the 3 sets of portable bleachers nearest the middle of the pool opposite the permanent bleachers. **No lawn/folding chairs** on will be allowed on the pool deck. There are 2 areas for handicapped spectators on the deck. The pool deck area should be clear for the teams, coaches, officials and workers. Also, there is a handicap accessible elevator. MUSTANG NATATORIUM REGULATIONS:

Buses shall park in the “Home” parking lot of the Football stadium (West of the football stadium).

Spectators shall park in the “Home” parking lot of the Football stadium or on the street in the marked spaces in front of the Baseball Field.

The West doors of the Performance Center may be used. Please use the ramp nearest the Tennis Courts.

The acoustics are less than excellent and the noise can be deafening. Announcements concerning events and heats will be made. However, each swimmer is solely responsible for making their event on time.

One way traffic permitted on the bulkhead from Lane 1 towards Lane 8.

No folding or lawn chairs on the deck. Spectators are asked to sit in the permanent bleachers.

UIL prohibits all types of artificial noisemakers within the facility.

Signs and banners cannot be taped or attached to the walls within the facility.

Glass items are prohibited within the facility.

Smoking is prohibited within the facility.

Pets are not allowed in the facility.

Headsets must be used with all radios, CD players and MP3 players.

UIL rules prohibit any shaving within the facility.

Please be aware of the foot ledge at either end of the diving well, as well as the starting end of the competition pool. The foot ledge is at a depth of 5 feet.

DIRECTIONS TO THE POOL

Directions to Andrews

From Odessa:

Hwy 385 North. Turn Left at the first stop light coming into Andrews. Follow Mustang Drive around to the football stadium. Turn right on the street past the parking lot in front of the Baseball Field. The football stadium will be towards your right and the Performance Center will be in front of you. To get to the pool go up the long ramp on the left side of the building nearest the Tennis Courts. The Natatorium will be down the hall.

From Big Spring:

Hwy 176 West. Turn Right at the first stop light coming into Andrews. Follow Mustang Drive around to the football stadium. Turn left on the street past the Baseball Field before you get to the parking lot for the football stadium. The football stadium will be towards your right and the Performance Center will be in front of you. To get to the pool go up the long ramp on the left side of the building nearest the Tennis Courts. The Natatorium will be down the hall.

From Seminole:

Hwy 385 South. Turn Right at the first stop light coming into Andrews. Follow Mustang Drive around to the football stadium. Turn left on the street past the Baseball Field before you get to the parking lot for the football stadium. The football stadium will be towards your right and the Performance Center will be in front of you. To get to the pool go up the long ramp on the left side of the building nearest the Tennis Courts. The Natatorium will be down the hall.

From Kermit & Eunice:

Hwy 176 East or Hwy 115 East. Turn Left onto Mustang Drive. Follow Mustang Drive around to the football stadium. Turn right on the street past the parking lot in front of the Baseball Field. The football stadium will be towards your right and the Performance Center will be in front of you. To get to the pool go up the long ramp on the left side of the building nearest the Tennis Courts. The Natatorium will be down the hall.
