

# Region 5 AAAA Swimming & Diving Championships February 11,12 & 13, 2010

**Welcome:** Magnolia I.S.D. is proud to host the Region 5 AAAA Swimming & Diving Championships this year. We wish the best of luck to all of you, and hope that you achieve all your goals.

**Location:** Magnolia High School is located on FM 1488 just east of Hwy. 149. Magnolia Natatorium is on the east side of the high school.

**Pool:** The pool consist of eight 9' lanes for competition and 5 lanes for continuous warm up and warm down on the other side of the bulkhead. The starting end of the pool is 13' deep and the turning end is 5'. The pool has an eight line LED Colorado scoreboard with a full automatic Colorado Timing System.

Warm up times and lane assignments will be sent to coaches by Tuesday, February 9<sup>th</sup>. Please fax your entries in no later than the entry deadline and provide an e-mail address with your entries and we will contact you regarding warm ups and any other important meet information.

**Entries:** Swimmers are automatically entered in the region meet through the district meet representative. If coaches are going to scratch a swimmer from an individual event in order to swim three (3) relays, every effort should be taken to do that at your district meet site. If not, all scratches must be done prior to the U.I.L. Region Meet Entry Deadline. Every effort will be made to contact the next qualifier in that event.

**Relay Events.** Once a swimmer swims on a relay it will count as one of their events allowed in the meet.

National H.S. Federation & U.I.L. rules apply to entry requirements. Please designate eight (8) competitors listed on your master entry form for relays. Relays must be declared prior to the start of that relay.

**Entry Fees:** The entry fee will be **\$4.00 per individual event entered and \$12.00 per relay.** Make Checks Payable to: Magnolia Independent School District

**Deadline:** Entries for the regional meet are due no later than Tuesday, February 9<sup>th</sup> by noon. Coaches should e-mail or fax their entries in on the standard U.I.L. entry form provided by the U.I.L. **Fax # (281) 356-1185.** Please make sure you indicate any scratches that need to be made. Swimmers will not be allowed to scratch an individual event in order to swim three (3) relays after the entry deadline.

**Diving sheets should be faxed with swimming entries and be declared on the official U.I.L. entry from.** Dive Sheets may change up to 1 hour prior to the start of the diving competition.

All amendments below are effective for the 2009-10 school year, unless otherwise noted.

- Allow swimming and diving consolation finals at the regional meet.

Medals 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> with Ribbons 4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> place

**Team Awards:**

**U.I.L. Plaque** for the first place team both girls and boys.

**TISCA Regional Competitor of the Meet** will be determined by the **NISCA Power Point rating system.**

The individual with the highest point totals in individual events will be recognized as the Regional Competitor of the Meet. In the event of a tie, head coaches, who are TISCA members will vote. 1 Girl and 1 Boy will receive this award.

**TISCA Regional Coach of the Year, Swimming & Diving**, and Coach's will vote to determine the swimming & diving Coach of the Year. The Diving Coach of the Year will be voted on following the diving competition and the Swimming Coach of the Year following the 100 Breaststroke. All ballots should be turned in to the region rep.

**Advancers:** The first place finisher in the each individual event and relay (Top 2 for Diving) will automatically advance to the U.I.L. State Meet. The next eight (8) swimmers with the best regional finals time from 2<sup>nd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place will also advance to the state meet.

**Meet Format:** This meet is a **Prelim / Finals Meet** with the top 8 times/places from prelims advancing to finals and the next 8 places (9<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup>) in prelims will advance to consolation finals. Swimming & Diving will be conducted based on the 2009-2010 U.I.L. and High School National Federation Rules.

**Awards Presentations:** Awards will be given out throughout the meet with breaks for awards. Only the 8 finalists will be recognized with the staging area at the north end of the bleachers in the hallway by the doors. Finalist are encouraged to dress in warm ups or in some type of team apparel when on the awards stand. The coach of the winning swimmer in that event or relay will hand out awards for that event.

***Diving will be awarded following of the diving event and will be announced again during the swimming competition finals.***

- Timing:** We will request help from teams for timing during the meet. If each team can provide at least 1 timer for the meet at all times, we will have the meet covered.
- Seating:** There will be assigned seating for teams with a section for spectators. Assigned seating areas will be determined based on the number of swimmers entered in the meet.
- Admission:** There will be a **\$3.00 admission fee** for adults and **\$1.00 for students** with a student I.D.
- T-Shirts:** Regional T-shirts will be available at the meet for purchase.
- Concessions:** Concessions & hospitality will be available throughout the meet.
- Hotel:** There are two (2) local hotels in Magnolia that are approximately 5 miles from the pool. There are plenty of hotels in The Woodlands, approx. 18 miles from the pool and in Tomball, approx. 12 miles from the pool.

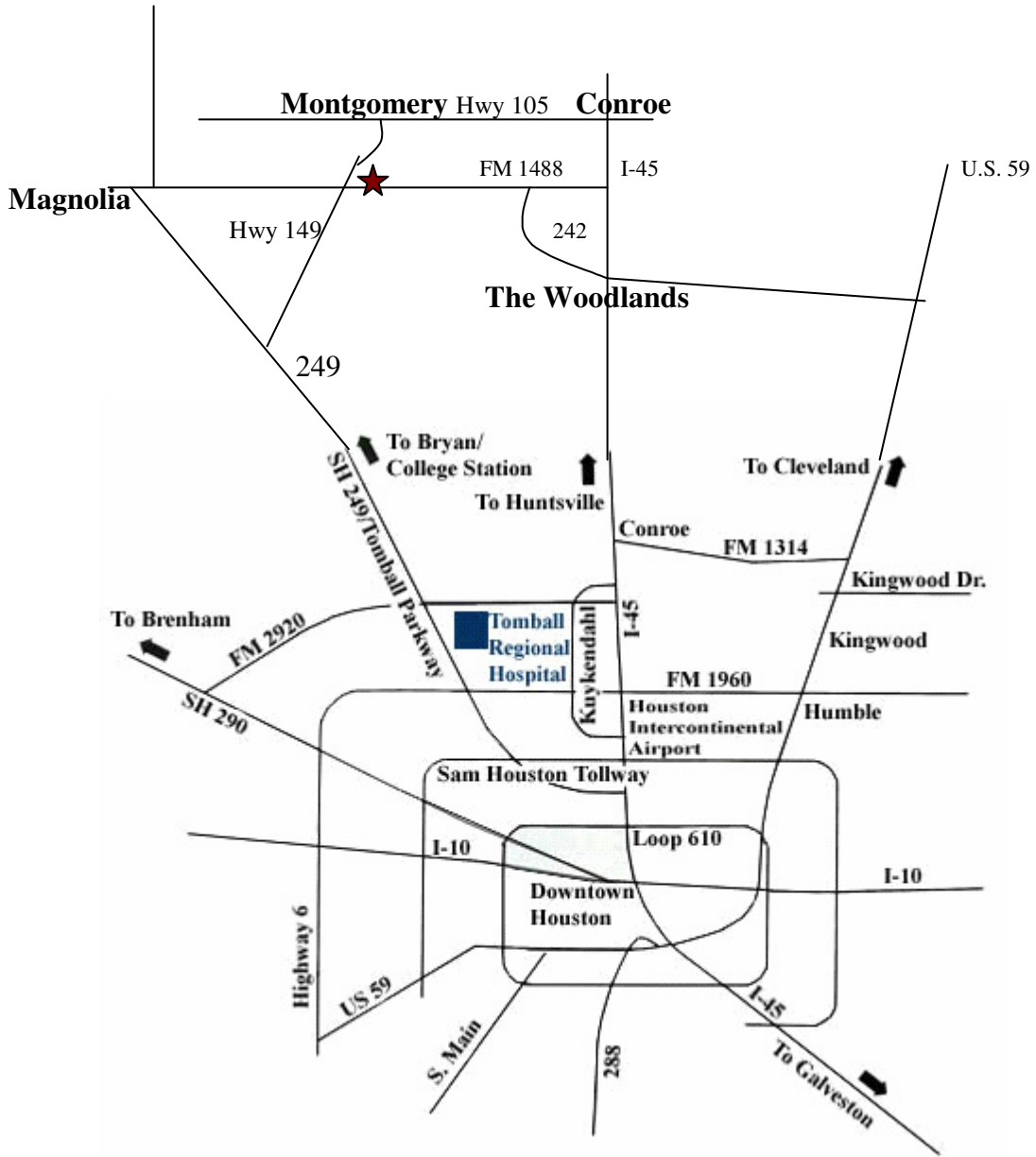
