

WESTERN HILLS **COWTOWN SHOOTOUT**

LOCATION: Wilkerson-Greines Activity Center Natatorium

FACILITIES: Indoor, eight lane 25 yard competition pool with non-turbulent lane lines and gutters. Competition pool depth from 13.5 feet to 5.5 feet. Nine lane warm up pool. Fully automatic Colorado Timing System with Aquagrip 8 foot touch pads and eight lane scoreboard display.

ENTRIES: Please enter all swimmers using Hy-Tek team manager. Indicate in email which swimmers are entering the pentathlon. Hy-tek Lite can be downloaded from Hy-Tek website.

ENTRY LIMIT: Each Swimmer may enter a maximum of **four (4)** events.
PLEASE BE SURE TO READ THE "SHOOTOUT" ENTRY RULES (BELOW) FOR ALL EVENTS SO SWIMMERS ARE NOT DISQUALIFIED FOR EXTRA EVENTS.

ENTRY FEES: A team entry fee will be assessed for entry to meet.
Boys Entry fee: \$ 100.00
Girls Entry fee: \$ 100.00
Teams may enter unlimited individuals in events.
Teams may enter unlimited relays in each event.

SHOOTOUT ENTRY RULES: The following rules will apply for this Unique meet situation.

1. Pentathlon: A swimmer may compete in the pentathlon (individual 50 Fly, Bk, Br, Fr, and 100 IM), which will be counted as **1** (one) event toward the 4 events maximum as per UIL rules regarding pentathlons. A swimmer **Must** swim all 4 events to be eligible for Pentathlon Championship award. **All swimmers will be entered into Pentathlon.**
2. Shootout: The 50 Free Shootout will consist of 5 rounds of the 50 Free (outlined below). All swimmers are eligible to swim the first round (Prelims) of the 50. After the prelim, swimmers advancing to further rounds will be based on a time and placing basis (see below) depending on the round of the swim. **Note: Swimmers who advance in rounds but fail to swim in a later round will be disqualified from all further competition in meet.**

SHOOTOUT FORMAT:

Prelims: All entrants may participate.

Quarterfinals: Top 16 fastest swimmers from the Prelims will compete in 4 heats of 4 swimmers. Top 8 times go on to semi-finals

Semi-Finals: Top 8 Swimmers from Quarter finals. Top 4 times go on to Finals

Finals: The top 4 swimmers will swim head to head and the top 2 times go on to Super-Finals

Super-Finals: Top 2 Swimmers will swim Head to Head for the Western Hills Shootout Championship.

Seeding: Swimmer with Fastest time will be placed in lane 4, second fastest swimmer will be in lane 5.

3. RELAYS: Relays are open to all meet participants and swimmers may enter relay events up to a maximum of four (4).

EVENT MAXIMUM NOTE: The Pentathlon event will be counted as **One (1)** event. Also, the Shootout will be counted from Prelim to Super-Final as **One (1)** event. Each relay

swum or entered will count as **One (1)** event toward an individual's total of four maximum events.

Ex. A swimmer competes in the Pentathlon, the Shootout and 2 relays. This swimmer has only entered 4 events.

SCORING

Individual Events: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Pentathlon Scoring: Swimmers will compete in all four Strokes and 100 IM. Times for all four races will be added together and the **LOWEST** aggregate time will be Considered the Pentathlon Champion. Swimmers either being Disqualified or failing to show for One (or more) events shall be assessed the slowest swimmers time from that event plus a :30 second time penalty. Points will not be generated for the Pentathlon in itself, however, points will be generated for general finish in pentathlon events with the exception of the 50 free, which will be scored by the finishing of the first round.

Shootout: There will be no points awarded for the Shootout, only the first round.

Relays: Relays will be scored through 8 places with Scoring as follows:

Relay Events: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

AWARDS:

Trophies will be awarded for the following:

- Male and Female Cowtown 50 Shootout Champion
- Male and Female Pentathlon Champion
- 1st and 2nd place team
- Ribbons given for 1-8th places in individual events and relays
