Swim facilities: The Natatorium will be configured into *two-25-yard* Competition Courses. The Competitive course will have eight (8) nine (9)foot lanes separated two (2) **STARK fiberglass bulkheads** housing a six (6)eight (8)foot lane 25-yard Warm-up/Cool-down Pool. There are two (2) **Daktronics** in-deck timing systems and one (1) on-deck system available as back-up. The Boys will compete in the seven (7') depth west pool and Girls in the fourteen (14') depth east pool. The Natatorium has two (2) independent display boards a full-feature **Daktronics ProStar** and a **Galaxy** monochrome matrix display for posting results and team scores. There are three (3) fully automated **Daktronics 2000** Timing systems, two dedicated to swimming and one to diving. Hy-Tech Software will be used. The **Grandstands** with Spectator seating for 1,100 are located on the second floor together with a complete **Concession** area. The Natatorium has 11,000 + sq.ft. the pool deck and can provide seating for 900 swimmers.

Diving facilities: Consist of four (4) One-Meter Maxi-Flex Diving Boards on concert platforms, Warm-up spa and w/drip showers on each of the two (2) Three-Meter platform bases. **Daktronics** wireless judging Systems and e-Dive software will be used.

Diving **Event 9** after the 50 freestyle & **Event 10** the 100 breaststroke.

*The time may be adjusted depending on 1.number of divers entered and 2.If the stadium is needed for a Play-off game and the Field House locker area (*North Side of Natatorium*) is needed. This competition will be conducted as a *championship meet*. **Events 9 & 10 – Girls & Boys 1-meter**, diver will perform eleven (11) dives, five (5) voluntary (*maximum d.d. 9.0*) and six (6) optional (*d.d. no limit*). **Events 23 & 24 – Girls & Boys 3-meter**, divers will perform six (6) dives, one (1) voluntary (*maximum d.d. 1.9, note the vol. dive D.D. can be greater than 1.9 but will be assigned a d.d. 1.9*) and six optional dives (*d.d. no limit*). Event 9 & 24 will run together first follow by a 30 minute warm-up then events 10 & 23. Please consult the National Federation Swimming & Diving Rule Book for choice and order of dives. As per Championship rules, all **dive sheets must be signed, and delivered (to the front information desk of the Natatorium) for final verification by 7:45 AM.**

Final results will be posted at the facility and on the "The Nat" Website.

Rules: U.I.L. and National Federation championship rules will govern the meet. Team Eligibility: Each school entered must have a coach/sponsor who is a current TISCA member. Membership applications may be found at <http://www.tisca.org>.

Awards:

Team trophies will be given to the top three (3) girls' teams and the top three (3) boys' teams. Individual Medals will be awarded to first, second, and third place in individual and relay events. Individual Ribbons will be awarded to fourth through eighth place in individual and relay events.

Entries: Team entries will be limited to TISCA Members-each contestant may enter a maximum of four (4) events. No more than two (2) may be individual events (diving counts as an individual event). **Each team may enter four (4) individuals and two (2) relays in each event. EXCEPTION: Each team may enter six (6) individuals in the 50 Free, 100 Free and 1-meter diving however, no more than (4) individuals from any team will be allowed to advance to any final.** Relays may be entered generically by school with actual swimmers being declared when relay cards are submitted at the meet. The order of the swimmers on the relay may be changed, with the exception of the lead off swimmer, until the completion of the heat as stated in the NISCA rules. Any swimmer listed on the school's roster is eligible to be placed on a relay as long as it does not violate the number of events per swimmer rule.

COACHES: PLEASE ADHERE TO TIME & DD STANDARDS.

Entry Procedure: **Swimming/Diving:** Enter your team with Team Manager II. Event file is posted on the Conroe ISD Swimming Web Site. **Do not send the Zip File.** Open the Zip File and send the file that ends with HY3.

Diving Sheets: Download and save the Diving Entry Form from the **CISD ISD Natatorium web site (at the bottom of the web page)**. Fill out the form, listing each diver and their dives. This meet will be conducted as a *championship meet*. The 1-meter diving shall consist of five voluntary dives and six optional dives and follow NFHS Rule #9, Section 4 Article 1, Section a, b, c, & d. The 3-meter shall consist of one voluntary dive and five optional dives. Submit the completed dive-sheet by e-mail to khandley@conroeisd.net **with swimming entries.**

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Entry Fees: \$7.00 per individual, regardless of the number of individual events entered. \$10.00 per relay entered. (As per Intra-District agreement, \$5.00 per individual, maximum entry fee per girls' team: \$50.00. Maximum entry fee per boys' team: \$50.00) Relay only swimmers **are required** to be on the team roster and do pay Individual Entry Fees. Entry Fees will be calculated based on the total number of Swimmers/Divers and relays entered.

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The CISD Natatorium Rules, Regulation, Prohibitions, and Deck Access

- All participants must follow the CDC “Healthy swimming policy” and shower before warm-up, no exception.
 - Shaving is not permitted anywhere within the entire CISD Natatorium Complex.
 - No chewing gum, food or color based drinks will be allowed on the pool deck, water only.
-
- Security personnel are empowered to enforce any and all regulations established by CISD Natatorium Policy.
 - Only participants, coaches, event administrators, and event volunteers are allowed on the pool deck – all spectators and parents must remain in the grandstand.
 - Participants in swim suits are not allowed in the Grandstand-seating area. Participants and spectators are not allowed to lean against glass the rails, climb over banisters / railings, or pass any posted barriers.
 - Participants and spectators are not allowed to use other areas of the CISD Natatorium complex during this event without securing a pass at the Services Desk located in the facility lobby.
 - Lawn Chairs are not allowed in the CISD Natatorium Grandstand-seating area, Stadium seats shall not exceed 17” wide x 13”deep.
 - Each competing team is permitted one temporary banner, placed at the discretion of the Aquatic Director. Team banners must not exceed 5’ by 8’. No handmade signage is allowed.
 - Absolutely no tobacco, alcohol products, or glass containers are allowed on Conroe School District property. This applies to the parking lot.
 - Spectators are allowed (1) Cooler 13” wide x 11” deep x 12” tall that can be placed directly under their seating area, Participant /Teams are allowed an Ice-Chest (1) PER GENDER on the deck provided they do not contain glass items, bottled water is allowed.
 - Betting and gambling is strictly prohibited.
 - Teams are expected to police their respective areas at the conclusion of the competition.
 - Participating or any activity that can be interpreted or described as “risky” or “horseplay” is prohibited throughout the entire CISD Natatorium Complex.
 - Diving equipment such as trampoline, spotting rigs, dry-board apparatus, and the warm-pool are not to be used unless authorized by the CISD Natatorium Director.
 - The use of flash cameras or noise-makers at the start, during or end of any race is prohibited.
 - Blocking or restricting fire lanes or emergency exits, and the use of emergency exits for non-emergency use is prohibited.

Access to the deck of the CISD Natatorium is restricted by pass to the following:

- Athletes from competing teams
- Administrative support personnel
- Coaches of competing teams
- Facility/District Staff
- Officials
- Marshals
- Timing System operators
- Security personnel
- Computer systems operators
- Lifeguards
- Lane timers
- Service and supply vendors
- Credentialed media personnel
- Hospitality personnel
- One photographer from each competing team
- Medical support personnel
- Other personnel on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the Meet Coordinator, the Meet Director, or the Meet Referee.



CISD Healthy Swimming Policy

CISD is committed to the health and safety of all patrons. *The CISD Natatorium* utilizes advanced training and technology and has adopted the Centers for Disease Controls (CDC) “*Healthy Swimming Policy*”. This policy protects our patrons and spectators from poor air or water quality hazards typical with indoor-swimming pools caused by microorganisms and chloramines. The cornerstone of this policy is based on guidelines which mandate safe practices such as requiring all participants to shower before entering the CISD Natatorium.

STANDARD SWIMMING SAFETY GUIDELINES AND WARM-UP PROCEDURES WILL BE IN EFFECT FOR ALL MEETS AND IS AS FOLLOWS:

Please remember coaches that all swimmers are required to follow the CDC "Health Swimming Policy" which is to Shower completely before the warm-up.

I. WARM-UP PROCEDURES

A. General Warm-up (First 30-45 minutes)

1. NO DIVING allowed from the blocks or edge of pool. Swimmers must enter pool feet first in a cautious manner.
2. No sprinting or pace work allowed during this general warm-up session.
3. All lanes to be used for general warm-up.

B. Specific Warm-up (Last 15 minutes)

1. Push/Pace lanes - Push off one or two lengths from starting end.
2. Diving Lanes - Sprint lanes for diving from blocks or for backstroke starts in specified lanes at designated times. One way only. Under coach supervision.
3. General Warm-up Lanes - No Diving. Circle swimming only.

II. SAFETY GUIDELINES

A. Coaches Responsibilities

1. Coaches shall instruct their swimmers regarding Safety guidelines and warm-up procedures as they apply to conduct at meets and practices.
2. Coaches shall actively supervise their swimmers throughout the warm-up session at meets.
3. Coaches should maintain as much contact with their swimmers as possible, both verbal and visual throughout the warm-up period.
4. Coaches should stand near the starting end of the pool when starting swimmers on sprint or pace work.
5. No one is permitted to climb over the railing separating the bleachers from the grandstands. Swimmers leaving the deck must be completely dry. All diving boards and equipment are **off limits**.

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
